July 4th celebrations can be a potentially dangerous and frightening time for pets. Help insure the health and safety of your pet by following these tips...



- ✓ keep your pet in a **SECURE** and quiet setting, like your home
(make sure all windows and doors are closed)
- ✓ turning on a television or radio will help mask the noise of fireworks, helping to keep your pet calm
- ✓ be certain your pet has a current MOA dog license, a current identification tag, and it's rabies tag securely fastened to it's collar
